

ARTIST INFORMATION

1. Who may apply to the Heard Guild Indian Market?

Our market abides by the American Indian Arts and Craft Act of 1990. The Act states that "An Indian is defined as a member of any federally or State recognized tribe, or an individual certified as an artisan by an Indian tribe." In addition, the Fair accepts Canadian Status Indians. In all cases the Guild requires copies of the relevant documentation.

2. Where and how may I get an application?

Applications are mailed to artists on our data base between late May and early June. At the same time the application is placed on the website, www.heardguild.org, and may be downloaded for your use. The Guild web site will continuously have updated information for the artists. You may also contact either Phyllis Noone, kpanaz@cox.net or 480-229-7068, or Jan Hoffmann, jawahoffmann@gmail.com or 480-225-8747. An artist may ask to be included on the data base at any time.

3. Is there an application fee?

NO, THERE IS NO APPLICATION FEE AT THE HEARD GUILD INDIAN FAIR & MARKET.

4. When is the application due?

The application is due on **July 30, 2011**. If you apply late, (after July 30, 2011 and by **Sept 2, 2011**) you must pay a late fee of \$75. We must receive that payment before a contract will be processed (around **October 1, 2011**)

5. What must I send with my application?

If you have pictures on file with the Guild of work completed after 12/2009 you do not have to send new pictures. If you are new or need to send new pictures, please send high quality photos, slides or **digital photos** (preferred). DIGITAL PHOTOS SHOULD BE IN JPEG FORMAT. If you are entering a new category, you must send new pictures in order to be judged in that category.

6. When will I know if I am accepted?

All applicants will be notified approximately mid-October of the status of their application.
