Class meets in Encanto Room, Dorrance Education Center of the Heard Museum from 9:00 AM - 12:30 PM. Class begins on Tuesday, October 6, 2020 and meets every Tuesday through April 27, 2021. Graduation will be held in late April, 2021, at the Heard Museum Guild Appreciation Dinner, date to be announced.

Please be aware of the following commitments:

- Students must be a member of the museum. Find the application for membership on the Heard Museum website. Various levels of membership are available.
- Students must be a member of the Heard Museum Guild. Memberships are \$40 per year and may be paid on the Heard Museum Guild website.
- **Students may miss no more than two non-consecutive classes to be allowed to become a guide.**
- A minimum of two years of guiding is expected after graduation and a minimum of 30 hours each year. *A typical day in a guide's schedule includes two to three tours and/or a period of roving so that for each day you guide you will be given 3 credits towards touring - It's easy to accumulate 30 hours September to May! This is the usual touring season.*
- Guiding will be with both adults and groups of children.

Please send your completed application form located on the Heard Museum Guild website. The tuition payment of **\$250** may be made on the Heard Museum Website, by credit card in the same location as the application form.

All students are required to provide information to the Museum Chief of Security for a background check.

The processing fee for the criminal background check is included in your tuition. If you already possess a current background clearance or if you wish to obtain one through law enforcement, please be prepared to present the clearance card to the Museum Chief of Security.

Applicants will be accepted up to a maximum of 20 students, however, no later than Monday, September 14, 2020.
