Images and Descriptions

Four (4) digital images of artwork in each of the selected classifications are required unless you submitted images for the 2017 or 2018 Fair. Three of the images must be of separate pieces and must be representative of what you plan to show and sell at the Fair. The fourth image may be a close-up of one of the pieces. Work must have been completed within the last two (2) years.

The image files must be in JPEG format and no larger than 1280 pixels on the longest dimension, and no larger than 2 MB (2,000 KB). If you want to submit images of a higher resolution, email them to excomm@heardguild.org or send them on a CD with this application. Include the same information about your artwork as requested below. Label the CD with your name and "IFM 2019."

The quality of the images you submit is critical: the better the images, the better your chance of being accepted into the Fair. Please contact us if you have any questions or concerns.
