- Three of the images must be of separate pieces and must be representative of what you plan to show and sell at the Fair. The fourth image may be a close-up of one of the pieces. Work must have been completed within the last two (2) years.
- The image files must be in JPEG format and no larger than 1280 pixels on the longest dimension, and no larger than 2 MB (2,000 KB), if submitted online. If you want to submit images of a higher resolution, email them to excomm@heardguild.org or send them on a CD with this application. Include the same information about your artwork as requested below. Label the CD with your name and "IFM 2020."
- **The quality of the images you submit is critical:** the better the images, the better your chance of being accepted into the Fair. Please contact us if you have any questions or concerns.
